Effects your students have gained

Every year new Year 8 class takes part of this project and for many students it is the first international project at our school. They have gained a wider knowledge of the world, different cultures and all the chosen SDGs. Their English skills have improved and they are more confident to share their ideas. Many students realized that at the moment we already have many important parts of our ideal world and community in our local town and that is worth to value.

Points for further improvement

This year we had students from two different Year 8 classes attending, so at the beginning it was harder to plan and organize the work as they had not worked together before.

Students needed more time for painting, so have to be better with the time management. As every group is different, it requires different approach for teaching and learning. By the time of the painting, they were much better team to work together.

Cross-cultural understanding	5	Students were very interested in making the posters about Japanese culture. They asked about the forum updates and were happy to see Japanese students` videos and introductions. They also learnt a lot from the Japanese side of a mural after receiving it.
Active learning	4	Students made posters about Japanese country and culture, climate, food and traditions. They created presentations about SDG's and came up with different ideas for the joint mural. They worked in teams and they really enjoyed it. They learnt to value their community and to complain less.
Critical thinking	4	Students tried to find solutions for the chosen SDG problems, but it was hard to come up with the solutions as many society and community problems have to be fixed on a higher level. At the same time they tried to think about the SDG's from the point of view where little changes start with individuals.

They also did a lot of team work, what they really enjoyed. They learnt to work with new team members and now they are more brave to express their ideas with each other.
